## **Expectations**

It is essential that all students come fully prepared for the new academic year. Please can we seek your support in ensuring your child comes with all of the necessary school stationary ready to be an active part in lessons, e.g. a well-stocked pencil case.

I have previously written to you about the importance we place on uniform standards. In order to commit to our ethos of community and equity, please can I remind you to review our uniform policy and ensure your child is appropriately dressed for the start of the year.

## **Developments**

Construction of our new student support centre is underway. Phase one of the new provision involves clearing the old library fixtures and fittings and 'making ready' for the newly designed student focussed spaces. The planned completion date is 1<sup>st</sup> September.

Work is also underway to replace our existing toilets in the Portsmouth block. The current traditional 'Boys' and 'Girls' toilets will be replaced with individual, open planned floor to ceiling cubicle toilets allocated to both boys and girls. The planned completion date is mid to late September.

We will also be relocating our medical room to a more central position. This will aid the triage of medical provision and will enable additional support to be more easily accessed for students and parents. The planned completion date is late September.
